Who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit,



Who is Saint Ignatius?

A brief history.

- Ante-Nicene Church Father
- Appointed the third bishop of Antioch by St. Peter.
- Likely knew the Apostle John.
- Legend has it, though unlikely, that he was the child Jesus picked up in Mark 9 & Matthew 18.



Who is Saint Ignatius?

A brief history.

- Likely born in Syria and converted to Christianity at a young age.
- Served as Bishop of Antioch for a long time (~40 years) from Evodius' death (~66 AD) until his death ~108 AD).
- Wrote several letters—seven considered authentic by most modern scholars and the Church.

Who is Saint Ignatius?

A brief history.

- Martyred in Rome understood to be by lions in the Coliseum.
- First known use of the term "Catholic" to refer to the Christian Church.
- The early Church saw many who claimed to preach the faith but weren't truly doing so.

et no man do anything connected with the Church without the bishop. Let that be deemed a proper Eucharist, which is [administered] either by the bishop, or by one to whom he has entrusted it.






